Regulations for the PIRELLI/BSMA BEST OF BRITISH
SERIES 08 Round 5 at CASTLE FARM , FARLEIGH
CASTLE on the 16th and 17th August 2008.

BSMA and AMX rules and constitution 2008 will apply.

Indemnity and Regulations

1. The agent/rider has read the rules set out in the booklet titled BSMA or AMX rules and constitution 2008 in so far as may be necessary and appropriate, the agent has informed the rider of the rules and shall abide by the rules at all times.
2. The agent shall notify this club if and when the rider develops or becomes subject to any mental or physical impediment, which would impair him/her to compete at these "events". At any event the medic's decision is **FINAL**.
3. The agent and rider together, or AMX rider, shall walk the entirety of the track on which the rider will compete to ensure that the rider is competent to compete on the circuit to ensure they have full knowledge of any difficulties of the track. This applies to both days of the two-day meeting.
4. The agent/rider agree together that the rider in competing in this event or events , freely accepts all risks of personal injury arising out of an accident whether fatal or otherwise and absolve Moredon Motocross Ltd, its officials and assistants, the landowners and medical personnel from all liabilities arising out of ant accident or incident causing damage to vehicles, machines or personal injury whether fatal or otherwise, howsoever caused.

RACING HOURS : 0800 Hrs to 1800 Hrs.
STRICTLY NO RIDING IN THE PITS**

There will be Signing on and Scrutineering on the Friday 15th August 08 . Times to be advised on arrival.

Signing on and Scrutineering will be closed at 08:15Hrs. on the Saturday 16th August 08.

Signing on and Scrutineering will be open on the Saturday EVENING,
Time to be advised on arrival.

Signing on and Scrutineering will be closed at 08:15 on the Sunday
17th August 08

Practice and racing will commence **NO LATER** than 9.00am on both
race days.

Riders to be at the start at the latest 5 minutes before their race, failure
to do so may result in exclusion from the race. Engines are not to be
started until permission is given. **IT IS A CONDITION OF THE
TRACK HIRE AGREEMENT THAT ENGINES ARE NOT TO
BE STARTED OR RUN OUTSIDE THE PERMITTED EVENT
HOURS ie. NOT BEFORE 8.00 am and NOT AFTER 6.00pm.**
There will be a **ONE HOUR** break approx. 1.00 pm to 2.00pm
with **DEAD ENGINES.** These noise requirements are imposed by
the track owners in order that racing can be retained at this
venue.

Exhaust sound testing will take place, all machines which fail will be
excluded from the meeting until successfully retested, time permitting.
Saturday night music etc./ generators will be curtailed at 11.00pm
(Sorry noise restrictions again)

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.

Spectators will be confined to spectator areas only. Spectators will
NOT cross the track whilst racing is in progress. **Prohibited** areas are
strictly out of bounds for all , other than officials and appointed
assistants.

Please respect the Landowner's property.

**ACCESS TO THE FARM BUILDINGS OF ANY KIND IS
ABSOLUTELY FORBIDDEN. CULPRITS WILL
IMMEDIATELY BE DISMISSED FROM THE EVENT**

Do not leave litter, please take it home, or put it in the skips provided.
NO TYRES IN THE SKIPS, PLEASE TAKE THEM HOME.

There is fresh water on site.

Chemical toilets must be emptied in the designated containers.

Any persons found damaging the marquee or toilet blocks will be sent
home immediately, and may be liable to prosecution .

Only proper barbeques are allowed, NO ground fires are permitted.
You are reminded that you are also responsible for your family and
friends actions throughout this weekend event.

You are responsible for the security of your belongings. 24 hour
Security will be present at this venue, which will mostly be involved
with the security of the site and the public spectators. Any person not

back on the site by midnight will need their competition licence or other means of identification to gain entry.

The local Police will be present during the whole weekend.

BE WARNED, THE POLICE WILL REMOVE ALL VEHICLES PARKED ON THE ROAD TO THIS EVENT.

This is a very high profile event attracting a lot of media/public attention. **Please for the good of the sport keep your language and actions to an acceptable level of decency**
